Purpose of Form: Authorize temporary guardian of estate for a minor ward.

Comments: There is a separate form, Letters of Guardianship (Minor Guardianship of the Estate) (GN-3345), for use in a permanent guardianship of a minor. For Adult Guardianships, use Letters for Guardianship of Person (GN-3200) and Estate (GN-3210) for permanent guardianships and Temporary Guardianship of the Person (GN-3260) and Estate (GN-3265) for temporary guardianships.
