Pursuant to Wis. STAT. § 758.13(2), and as Chairperson of the Wisconsin Judicial Council's Appellate Procedure Committee (APC), I write regarding the above-referenced matter. Although the Judicial Council was not among the "interested parties" provided notice of this petition on May 26, 2023, our executive committee has since become aware of it. This pending rules petition is of keen interest to APC and to the Judicial Council generally. Accordingly, we intend to study the materials submitted and to provide observations on the matter as soon as practicable.
