PETITION TO MODIFY SCR 20:1.9(c)

To: The Justices of the Supreme Court

Attorneys Michael D. Cicchini and Terry W. Rose hereby petition the Court to amend SCR 20:1.9(c).

I. The Proposed Change

The proposed amended rule is stated in its entirety, below. No language has been deleted from the existing rule; proposed additions have been underlined.

- (c) A lawyer who has formerly represented a client in a matter or whose present or former firm has formerly represented a client in a matter shall not thereafter <u>do either of the following</u>:
 - (1) <u>Use</u> information relating to the representation to the disadvantage of the former client except as these rules would permit or require with respect to a client, or when the information has become generally known. "<u>Generally known</u>" information includes information that is publicly available or has been disclosed in a public forum.
 - (2) <u>Reveal</u> information relating to the representation except as these rules would permit or require with respect to a client. <u>Information that is "generally known" has already been revealed.</u>

II. Reasons for the Change

The reasons for the change are described in the petitioners' supporting memorandum. Briefly, the existing SCR 20:1.9(c) prevents an attorney from discussing, writing about, or otherwise disclosing even *public* information about his or her closed cases. This existing rule: (1) conflicts with statutes and other ethics rules; (2) harms the legal profession by preventing effective lawyer CLE; (3) runs contrary to the public's interest in receiving accurate commentary about the legal system; (4) violates attorney free speech rights by preventing lawyers from discussing, writing about, or otherwise disclosing even *widely and publicly available* information; and (5) does not serve any of its own stated objectives.
