Name of Form: Notice of Registration of Out-of-State Judgment or Order

Form Number: FA-4185V

Purpose of Form: To provide notice to the non-registering party that a foreign order has been registered, and to inform the individual regarding how to object to the registration.

Who Completes It: Clerk of Court's Office

Distribution of Form: Court, Filing Party, Filing Party Attorney, Non-Filing Party, Child Support Agency

Accompanying Forms: For Support or Maintenance Orders, a copy of the registered order and any documents and relevant information accompanying the order should accompany the Notice when sent to the non-registering party.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 01/21.

Modifications: Added a section to enter child support and/or maintenance arrears.

Comments: To Object to the Registration, form FA-4186V may be used.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
