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**Name of Form:** Letters of Guardianship (Minor Guardianship of the Estate)

**Form Number:** GN-3345

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**Statutory Reference:** §§54.18, 54.19, 54.20, 54.46(5), 54.52, and Chapter 54, Wisconsin Statutes

**Benchbook Reference:** GA-4

**Purpose of Form:** Authorize the guardian of the estate of a minor ward to act.

**Who Completes It:** Petitioner or attorney.

**Who Signs It:** **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner.

**Distribution of Form:** Court, Guardian and interested persons as required by statutes.

**Accompanying Forms:**

**New Form/Modification:** Modified; last update 05/20.

**Modifications:** Added option to authorize guardian to exercise all powers under 54.20(3) that do not require court approval, or all powers except specific powers.

**Comments:** There is a separate form for minor guardianships of the person, Letters of Guardianship and Dispositional Order Appointing Guardian (JN-1530) and Letters of Temporary Guardianship (Minor Guardianship of the Estate) (GN-3265) for temporary guardianships.

For Adult Guardianships, use Letters for Guardianship of Person (GN-3200) and Estate (GN-3210) for permanent guardianships and use Letters of Temporary Guardianship of the Person (GN-3260) and Estate (GN-3267) for temporary guardianships.
