Purpose of Form:	To appoint a Full, Limited, or Temporary Guardian of the child and issue letters of guardianship and dispositional order appointing guardian for an Indian child.
Who Completes It:	COURT: Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL.
Distribution of Form:	Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s Guardian, child’s Legal Custodian, child’s Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Tribe, Indian Custodian, and any Additional Interested Persons.

Comments:	To order Minor Guardianship of the Estate, use GN-3330. For Dispositional Order Appointing an Emergency Guardian, use form JN-1521. The court may appoint coguardians of the person for a child, subject to any conditions that the court imposes. Unless the court orders otherwise, any decision concerning the child must be concurred in by all coguardians or is void. Wis. Stat. §48.9795 (2)(b)(4). If coguardians are ordered, both names shall be included on the order.
