Comments:	<p>RMC recommends that the court not rely upon attachments alone as the basis for its findings. Where attachments are used, specific reference to the document title, page and paragraph should be made.</p> <p>For the court to impose non-secure out-of-home placement on the juvenile, the court must make the findings contained in paragraph 3.</p> <p>When the court imposes and stays non-secure out-of-home placement, a hearing must be held before the stay can be lifted as to the out-of-home placement. A hearing may be waived for placement in secure detention.</p>
