On July 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Supreme Court issued an order adopting amendments relating to the discovery of electronically stored information. The amendments to Wis. Stat. §§ 802.10, 804.01, 804.08, 804.09, 804.12, and 805.07 are effective January 1, 2011, but are subject to revision following a public comment period and public hearing this fall. IT IS ORDERED that on Thursday, September 30, 2010, at 9:30 a.m. in the Supreme Court Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, the court will hold a public hearing and open administrative conference during which the court will review the amendments and any written comments that are filed following the issuance of this scheduling order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all comments shall be submitted in writing and are due by August 31, 2010. Any comments shall

be filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court, P.O. Box 1688, Madison, WI 53701-1688, and emailed to clerk@wicourts.gov.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice of the hearing be given by publication of a copy of this scheduling order and of the court's order dated July 6, 2010 in the official state newspaper once each week for three consecutive weeks and in an official publication of the State Bar of Wisconsin not more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the date of the hearing.
