RE: Submission from Attorney William C. Gleisner, III with regard to State Bar Rule Petitions 13-7 and 13-13, which are scheduled for Administrative Conference, February 24, 2014

Honorable Justices:

This letter is in response to Attorney Gleisner's letter of February 21, 2014.

Attorney Gleisner headlines his page two as "Problems with the Nomination Process." To provide you a complete picture of the process, I offer the following.

Attorney Gleisner contacted State Bar President Patrick Fiedler and Nomination Committee Chair George Burnett after the Nomination Committee had selected the nominees for Judicial Council. As was published in the State Bar of Wisconsin's Inside Track newsletter on August 21, September 18, and October 16, 2013, members who wished to be considered for nomination or self-nomination were asked to contact my executive coordinator, Jan Marks. (See Attachment A) We heard from only one person expressing interest and she was nominated by the Committee. Attorney Gleisner never contacted Jan Marks or me prior to early November, when he contacted President Fiedler and then Nomination Committee Chair Burnett on November 4 and 5, after the committee had selected and received the approval of two candidates for nomination to the Judicial Council.

Attorney Gleisner did submit nomination papers on November 24, 2013, as he states. Unfortunately, he did not contact Jan Marks, as he had done in 2010-11, to receive a copy of a petition or her letter requesting that individuals print their names in addition to signing their names. As stated in my email to him at the time (see Attachment B) we must verify the signatures. We do this to comply with Article II, Section 1(b) of the State Bar Bylaws that "Other persons may be nominated for any of said offices by petition. Each nominee must provide a petition signed by not less than one hundred active members of the Association." (emphasis added) In the past, we have found inactive members and non-voting judicial members signing petitions. Many of the signatures submitted by Attorney Gleisner were

illegible (see Attachment C for an example) and it was impossible to verify if they were even members, let alone eligible to sign a petition. As I stated to Attorney Gleisner at the time, everyone, I believe, signs a nomination petition with good intentions. But that does not mean they are eligible to sign the petition.

Attorney Gleisner then implies that it took 310 signators to place him on the ballot, when, once he reached 100 verifiable signators, he was placed on the ballot and added to the State Bar website along with the other candidates. That he continued to submit signed petitions long after the public announcement of his candidacy was his choice.

Had Attorney Gleisner contacted Jan Marks as requested prior to submitting nomination papers, or, if he had simply followed the same procedure he successfully and easily followed in 2010-11 there would have been no problems. (See Attachment D)

The next section of page two of Attorney Gleisner's letter is labeled "Problems with the Ballot Bio." Attached, at E, please find the letter with examples that was sent to all candidates regarding submission of their biographies. He was asked to change the ending of his biographical statement because it was a campaign statement. Again, had Attorney Gleisner followed the same example as all the other candidates and as he also did successfully in 2010-11, there would be no problems.

In summary, had Attorney Gleisner followed the same practices and procedures that have been in place for over twenty years, procedures that have been easily complied with by all other self-nominated candidates for president-elect, governor, as well as by himself in 2010-2011, none of the issues he identifies as problems would have existed.

Bill,

Thanks for dropping off the additional signatures today for your nomination to the Judicial Council. Unfortunately, only one of the eleven submitted it legible. Additionally, only about 40 of the previous 104 submitted are legible. Individual signators did not print their names on the petitions as they did the last time you ran. We ask this to ensure that we can read the names as we check every signature to verify that the member signing the petition is an active member who is eligible to vote. Everyone signs with the best intentions, but we do find members who are ineligible because they are inactive members sometimes signing petitions. This is the same process in which we engage when candidates self-nominate for the Board of Governors or any other office. And this is why on the website we recommend that people submit a typewritten list of the signators and call Jan Marks so that she has the opportunity to talk with potential self-nominated candidates.

When you ran in 2011, you contacted Jan Marks, my executive coordinator, about the process. She talked with you and sent you the letter that is attached. If you wish to have us verify all those signators already submitted, I would request that you submit a typewritten list in the same order that the petitions were submitted so that we can qualify them. Additionally, please submit the same for all future signators or have them print their name next to their signature so that we can verify them as well.






