2015AP1024-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Zachary James Marek (L.C. # 2013CF176)

Before Kloppenburg, P.J., Sherman, and Blanchard, JJ.

By prior order, we questioned whether there would be arguable merit to further proceedings related to appellant Zachary Marek's suppression motion. We also noted that the sentencing court relied on COMPAS assessments, and that there may be arguable merit to a challenge to sentencing depending on the supreme court's decision in *State v. Loomis*, appeal no. 2015AP157-CR. Attorney Melissa Petersen, appointed counsel for Marek, now informs us that she intends to file a postconviction motion claiming ineffective assistance of trial counsel. Attorney Petersen requests that we extend the time to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal to forty days from the supreme court's decision in *Loomis*.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this no-merit appeal is
