Name of Form: Petition for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Petition and Motion for Injunction Hearing (Harassment – 30711)

Purpose of Form: Petition in civil court initiating an action for a TRO/final injunction in harassment matters.

Who Completes It: Petitioner.

Distribution of Form: Original to court; copies to person to be protected and/or petitioner, respondent, and law enforcement.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none unless the petitioner adds pages with additional factual allegations.

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 03/26.

Modifications: Revised and reformatted form to increase accessibility and usability, including clarifying party types.

Comments: As of March 2026, this form can be used for harassment cases in civil court or juvenile court. Form JC-1693 was discontinued. File this form in civil court when an adult files against another adult, or when a parent, attorney, or other adult files on behalf of a child victim, and the respondent is an adult. File this form in juvenile court only if the respondent is a child OR if there is a pending CHIPS action in the juvenile court involving the child victim.

There has been confusion over whether to appoint a guardian ad litem (GAL) for a child petitioner in harassment TRO/Injunction cases. By statute, a GAL should be appointed for a child petitioner in a harassment TRO (§ 813.125(2)(b) – effective July 1, 2010).
