<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Court. The clerks of court will authenticate copies. Party will provide to the newspaper for publication and serve the family court commissioner.

<b>Modifications:</b>	Pursuant to 2019 WI Act 30, updated to add party/attorney address, email address, and telephone number.
<b>Comments:</b>	The newspaper will provide a declaration of the publication dates that must be filed with the Clerk of Court.
