<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To appoint a full, limited, or temporary Guardian of the child and issue letters of guardianship and dispositional order appointing guardian.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	Court (Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner). <b>This is a final order for the purpose of appeal.</b>
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s Guardian, child’s Legal Custodian, child’s Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, and any Additional Interested Persons.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modification; last update 10/25.
<b>Modifications:</b>	Added “This includes educational decision-making authority.” to the legal custody duty and authority within the full and limited guardianships.
<b>Comments:</b>	<p>To order minor guardianship of the estate, use GN-3330.</p> <p>For an Indian child, use the Indian Child Welfare Act version, form IW-1530.</p> <p>For dispositional order appointing an emergency guardian, use form JN-1521.</p> <p>The court may appoint co-guardians of the person for a child, subject to any conditions that the court imposes. Unless the court orders otherwise, any decision concerning the child must be concurred in by all co-guardians or is void. Wis. Stat. § 48.9795 (2)(b)(4). If co-guardians are ordered, both names shall be included on the order.</p> <p>This form is available in Spanish.</p>
