**Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).**

By order dated May 18, 2026, this court directed Attorney Jill M. Skwor, appellate counsel for Deangelo Maurice Lockette, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Appellate counsel now advises that the case presents an issue of arguable merit that must be presented to the circuit court. Appellate counsel therefore requests voluntary dismissal of this appeal and an extension of appellate deadlines to permit the filing of a postconviction motion under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30(2)(h). A no-merit appeal is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that further postconviction proceedings would be wholly frivolous. *McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 438 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant relief.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report in this matter is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without prejudice. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.18(1).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for Luckette to file a postconviction motion under WIS. STAT. RULE 809.30 is extended through August 7, 2026. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
