2024AP1194-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. David N. Olguin (L.C. # 2023CF601)

Before Donald, C.J., Geenen, and Petrashek, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

By order dated June 9, 2026, we directed Attorney Jill Skwor to file a supplemental no-merit report regarding potential issues relating to David N. Olguin's plea and his knowledge of the elements of his offense. In lieu of the report, counsel moves to voluntarily dismiss this appeal and to extend the time for filing a postconviction motion, as counsel indicates that she has determined there is a meritorious claim to pursue. Because a no-merit report is only appropriate if counsel is convinced that an appeal would be wholly frivolous, *McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988), this court will grant the motion.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report in appeal No. 2024AP1194-CRNM is rejected and the appeal is dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for Olguin to file a postconviction motion or notice of appeal is extended to sixty days after the date of this order. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a) (2023-24).
