2013AP1743-CRNM State of Wisconsin v. Willie Bernard Johnson (L.C. #2012CM1927)

Before Curley, P.J.

By order dated December 29, 2014, this court directed Attorney Aneeq Ahmad, appellate counsel for Willie Bernard Johnson, to file a supplemental no-merit report in this matter. Attorney Ahmad now advises that, in his view, the case presents an arguably meritorious issue. Counsel therefore seeks voluntary dismissal of the no-merit appeal and an extension of the deadline for pursuing postconviction relief in the circuit court. A no-merit proceeding is appropriate only if counsel is convinced that an appeal would be wholly frivolous. *McCoy v. Court of Appeals*, 486 U.S. 429, 437 (1988). Accordingly, the court will grant the motion.

Counsel does not state how much time he requires to prepare a postconviction motion. The court

will establish an appropriate deadline.

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this appeal is dismissed without

prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for filing a postconviction motion or

notice of appeal is extended through March 30, 2015. See WIS. STAT. RULE 809.82(2)(a)
