State of Wisconsin v. Caleb J. Rave (L.C. # 2012CF205)

Before Kloppenburg, P.J., Higginbotham and Blanchard, JJ.

By prior order in this no-merit appeal, we questioned whether it would be wholly frivolous to argue that trial counsel was ineffective by failing to move to dismiss the complaint prior to retrial based on double jeopardy grounds. Attorney Susan Alesia, appointed counsel for appellant Caleb Rave, now informs us that she has determined that the issue we identified in our order has arguable merit and that Rave wishes to pursue it. Attorney Alesia informs us that the State Public Defender is appointing outside counsel to pursue a postconviction motion, and

moves to extend the time to file a postconviction motion to sixty days from appointment of successor counsel. The motion shows good cause.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and this no-merit appeal is dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time to file a postconviction motion is extended to sixty days from the appointment of successor counsel.
