Yotahm Veasey v. FII USA, Inc. (L.C. #2023CV348)

Before Gundrum, P.J., Neubauer, and Grogan, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

FII USA, Inc., petitioned for leave to appeal the circuit court's order denying FII USA's motion to dismiss. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.50 (2023-24). We granted that petition. After reviewing the record and the briefs, we conclude that the petition for leave to appeal should be summarily dismissed as improvidently granted, and the order staying the circuit court proceedings should be vacated. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for leave to appeal is summarily dismissed as improvidently granted, the order staying the circuit court proceedings is vacated, and the cause is remanded to the circuit court for further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
