Timothy B. Wilks v. Wisconsin Parole Commission  
(L.C. ## 2023IP8 and 2024CV37)

**Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).**

Appellant Timothy Wilks, pro se, appeals an order that quashed as untimely his petition for a writ of certiorari challenging a denial of parole. The Wisconsin Parole Commission has now filed what it describes as its “non-opposition to a reverse and remand order to be issued by this court.” The Commission states that a review of the recent supplemental record “indicates that Wilks’s petition was timely filed under WIS. STAT. § 893.735.” We conclude that this case is appropriate for summary disposition. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.21.

Based on the State's concession, we will summarily reverse the order without reviewing the merits of Wilks's appeal and remand the matter to the circuit court for further proceedings consistent with this opinion and order.

Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the order is summarily reversed and the matter is remanded to the circuit court for further proceedings. *See* WIS. STAT. RULE 809.21.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
