2024AP2034-NM

St. Croix County v. S. J. L. (L. C. No. 2023GN65)

Before Stark, P.J., Hruz, and Gill, JJ.

Summary disposition orders may not be cited in any court of this state as precedent or authority, except for the limited purposes specified in WIS. STAT. RULE 809.23(3).

Counsel for S.J.L. has filed a no-merit report, pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and WIS. STAT. RULE 809.32 (2023-24), concluding that no grounds exist to challenge orders for S.J.L.'s guardianship and protective placement. S.J.L. has filed a response to the no-merit report, raising multiple issues.

Upon our initial review of the record and the no-merit report, as mandated by *Anders*, this court identified a potential issue of arguable merit. By order dated June 12, 2025, we therefore directed appellate counsel to either: (1) file a supplemental no-merit report explaining why that potential issue lacked arguable merit; or (2) move to voluntarily dismiss this no-merit appeal and seek an extension of the time in which to file a postdisposition motion.

Appellate counsel has now filed a motion for voluntary dismissal of this no-merit appeal

and for an extension of the time to file a postdisposition motion. Accordingly, we reject the

no-merit report, dismiss the appeal without prejudice, and extend the time for S.J.L. to file a

postdisposition motion.

Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the no-merit report is rejected and the appeal is dismissed without

prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time for filing a postdisposition motion is extended

to 45 days from the date of this summary disposition order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this summary disposition order will not be published.
