



The Board of Bar Examiners (BBE) was formed on January 1st, 1991, from two existing Wisconsin Supreme Court boards: the Board of Continuing Legal Education and the Board of Bar Commissioners.

The Board of Continuing Legal Education was created to administer the Wisconsin Supreme Court's mandatory continuing legal education (CLE) requirements for lawyers. The Board of Bar Commissioners was charged with administering bar admission and compliance with the Code of Professional Responsibility. These functions are now combined under BBE.
