Wisconsin Supreme Court accepts one new case

Madison, Wisconsin (Oct. 27, 2022) – The Wisconsin Supreme Court recently voted to accept one new case, and the Court acted to deny review in a number of other cases. State v. A.G.

Supreme Court case type: Petition for Review

Court of Appeals: District I

Circuit Court: Milwaukee County, Judge Ellen R. Brostrom, reversed

Long caption: In re the termination of parental rights to A.G., a person under the age of 18: State of Wisconsin, Petitioner-Respondent-Petitioner v. A. G., Respondent-Appellant

Issues presented by the Guardian ad Litem:

1. Whether criminal procedures prescribed in Bangert (State v. Bangert, 131 Wis. 2d 246, 389 N.W.2d 12 (1986)) regarding review of a motion to withdraw plea should rigidly apply to termination of parental rights proceedings.
2. Whether a respondent parent loses their right to appeal after failing to attend a remand hearing for which they were provided sufficient notice of the hearing and for which there is no excuse given for their lack of appearance.

Issue presented by the State:

1. Was A.G.'s plea entered knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily?

(Justice Patience Drake Roggensack did not participate)

Review denied: The Supreme Court denied review in the following cases.
