- IV. Rule Petition 11-08: In the Matter to Amend SCR 40.02(2) and to Create SCR 40.055 and 40.14(3)(i) Relating to the Legal Competence Requirements of Graduates of Law Schools in Other Nations; Fees. Filed 11/18/11; Follow-up letter to BBE—response due 2/15/12. Staff preliminary memo circulated 2/15/12. Court discussed at 2/27/12 open administrative conference. Court voted to hold public hearing. Public hearing scheduled for 5/16/12; notice issued 3/2/12; public input letter sent 3/28/12. Hearing held 5/16/12. Court voted unanimously to return petition to BBE for further development (with directions to consult with reps of UW Law School & Atty. Shneidman). Order issued 7/5/12. Amendment filed by BBE 8/15/12. Staff memo with revised draft circulated 9/12/12. Court discussed at 9/19/12 open conference. Court approved draft rule. Draft order and cover memo circulated 10/16/12; if approvals not received, then discuss at 10/31/12 open administrative conference.

Court voted 6-1 to solicit public comment and schedule for further discussion at future open conference (AWB would have held public hearing). - XI. <u>Information Item</u>: Rule Petition 12-10: Petition to amend Supreme Court Rule 22.24 Relating to Costs Assessments in the Lawyer Regulation System, filed by OLR on 9/11/12. Preliminary memo circulated 9/24/12. Court discussed at 9/27 open administrative conference. Court voted unanimously to solicit public comment on the petition from standard list as well as those other persons/entities as stated on the record and schedule for further discussion at future open administrative conference. **Public comment letter sent 10/17/12; schedule for discussion at 11/30/12 open administrative conference.**
- XII. <u>Information Item</u>: 2011 Wisconsin Act 209 creating a fee waiver program for veterans. Under the legislation, veterans who meet the eligibility requirements would receive a waiver of the initial licensing fee for most licenses granted by state agencies. The act also requests the Supreme Court to promulgate a rule waiving the initial admission fee for lawyers admitted to practice. <u>See</u> § 751.153. Letter to BBE & State Bar (sent 6/7/12) referring the matter for consideration and determination of whether a petition seeking a change to the court rules might be appropriate; response received.
