Purpose of Form: Defers entry of judgment of conviction for first time offenders in certain misdemeanor drug possession cases. Upon successful completion of probation, the case will be dismissed.

Who Completes It: The court.

Who Signs It: **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Clerk of Circuit Court/Deputy Clerk.

Distribution of Form: Court. Copies to defense attorney, district attorney, and probation.

Modifications: Revised purpose and comments sections of form summary.

Comments: The defendant is found guilty of the crime, but the judgment of conviction and sentencing are deferred pending completion of probation. If probation is successful, the case is dismissed. If probation is unsuccessful, then judgment will be entered and the defendant sentenced.
