Purpose of Form:	To petition for judgment of unpaid restitution or supervision fees against the defendant and in favor of the person or agency owed the restitution or supervision fees. To be used in cases in which a probation term has been revoked or has discharged, or a parole or extended supervision term has terminated or will terminate in the near future.
Who Completes It:	The Division of Community Corrections, Department of Corrections, would complete the form and submit it to the court for signing by the judge.
Distribution of Form:	Criminal case file. The Clerk is required to docket the judgment without fee. Send a copy to the Department of Corrections and the defendant in all instances, and to the victim(s) if the judgment is for unpaid restitution.
