<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To order unpaid restitution or supervision fees against the defendant and in favor of the person or agency owed the restitution or supervision fees. To be used in cases in which a probation term has been revoked or has discharged, or a parole or extended supervision term has terminated or will terminate in the near future.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	The Division of Community Corrections, Department of Corrections, would complete the form and submit it to the court for signing by the judge.
<b>Who Signs It:</b>	<b>BY THE COURT:</b> Circuit Court Judge.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Criminal case file. The Clerk is required to docket the judgment without fee. Send a copy to the Department of Corrections and the defendant in all instances, and to the victim(s) if the judgment is for unpaid restitution.
