Comments:	Based on the Hemp decision, the form was changed to address the non-probation/non-incarceration cases only. DOC has created a new form (DOC-2678), Certificate of Discharge and Satisfaction of Probation Conditions for Expungement to trigger expunction in those case types.
	2009 Wisconsin Act 28 expanded the criteria for requesting expunction of an adult conviction to include Class H and Class I felonies. Act 28 makes expunction mandatory in invasion of privacy cases (voyeurism) under §942.08(2)(b), (c), or (d) if the defendant was under age 18 on the date of the offense.
