<b>Modifications:</b>	Deleted “ <input type="checkbox"/> ” before setting a time for a hearing. Deleted notary section and added a declaration statement.
<b>Comments:</b>	<p>Available in Spanish and Hmong.</p> <p>2013 WI Act 311, added extension of injunction language; changed language that petitioner must obtain from sheriff or private process server an affidavit that service was unsuccessful because respondent was avoiding service by concealment and added that the mailing or sending of a facsimile may be omitted if the post-office address or facsimile number cannot be ascertained with due diligence.</p> <p>This form is to be used for harassment cases in civil court. It is to be used when an adult files against another adult, or when a parent, attorney, or other adult files on behalf of a child victim, and the respondent is an adult. Form JC-1693 is used in juvenile court. Orders can now remain in effect for four years.</p> <p>There has been confusion over whether to appoint a GAL for a child petitioner in harassment TRO/Injunction cases. By statute, a GAL should be appointed for a child petitioner in a harassment TRO (§813.125(2)(b) – effective July 1, 2010).</p>
