	The order can only enjoin conduct, or substantially similar conduct, which forms the finding of harassment. <i>Bachowski v. Salamone</i> , 139 Wis. 2d 397, 414 (1987).
	The firearm prohibition is discretionary with the judge in a harassment petition. This is different from a domestic abuse or child abuse injunction in which the firearm prohibition is mandatory .
	Can be used for juvenile proceedings.
