New Form/Modification: Modified, last revision 01/07.

Modifications: Add Wamboldt language. This is a final order for purpose of appeal if signed by a circuit court judge.

Comments: This form allows for either immediate dismissal or dismissal after 20 days. It further directs whether the dismissal is with or without prejudice.

If the dismissal is immediate, the case is over. If the order is contingent on whether a good cause showing is made, the clerk should "tickle" the matter for approximately 30 days after it was sent. If there has been no further action in the case, it should be dismissed without further order of the court. If a motion is filed requesting that the matter not be dismissed, the clerk should determine if it has been scheduled for hearing. If not, consult with the court to determine what further action is necessary.
