Comments: An individual at risk is defined as either an

- Adult at risk (an adult who has a physical or mental condition that substantially impairs his/her ability to care of his/her needs and who has experienced, is currently experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, treatment without consent, unreasonable confinement or restraint, financial exploitation neglect, or self-neglect).
- Elder adult at risk (a person age 60 or older who has experienced, is currently experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, treatment without consent, unreasonable confinement or restraint, financial exploitation neglect or self-neglect).
