Name of Form: Affidavit of Mailing

Purpose of Form: To provide a document by which a person who has served documents by mail upon another person can sign under oath the necessary information concerning that service.

Who Completes It: The person who has actually prepared and mailed the documents fills out the information concerning the documents that were mailed, seeks out a notary public and, after being sworn, signs the document. The notary public will complete the notarial section.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court after it has been signed and notarized.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 11/19.

Modification: Added remote notary statement pursuant to 2019 WI Act 125.
