Name of Form: Stipulation Suspending Proceedings to Effect Reconciliation

Form Number: FA-4144VA

Statutory Reference: §767.323, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form: If the parties want to try to preserve their marriage and seek reconciliation while the action is pending (but not have the case dismissed at that point), this form is used to sign the stipulation to that effect.

Who Completes It: The parties would complete and sign the document and present it to the court for signature.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court. Other parties should retain a copy.

Accompanying Forms: None.

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 11/13.

Modification: Incorporated same sex divorce language. Added, “if either party is receiving public assistance or there is a caseworker from the Child Support Agency, we are providing them a copy of this stipulation” and “PARTIES MUST INCLUDE A PROPOSED ORDER THAT WILL ONLY BECOME ENFORCEABLE IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE OR CIRCUIT COURT COMMISSIONER.”
