Name of Form: Motion to Revoke Suspension of Proceedings to Effect Reconciliation

Form Number: FA-4145VA

Statutory Reference: §767.323, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form If an attempt to reconcile does not succeed, the party wanting to terminate the suspension and reinstate the original divorce/legal separation proceeding uses this form.

Who Completes It: The party seeking reinstatement of the proceedings would complete the motion and present the order to the court for signature.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court. A copy must be provided to the other parties, Family Court Commissioner and Child Support Agency (if there are minor children).

Accompanying Forms: None.

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 10/06.

Modification: Incorporated same sex divorce language. Added, “if either party is receiving public assistance or there is a caseworker from the Child Support Agency, we are providing them a copy of this stipulation” and “PARTIES MUST INCLUDE A PROPOSED ORDER THAT WILL ONLY BECOME ENFORCEABLE IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE OR CIRCUIT COURT COMMISSIONER.”

Comments: Split for eFiling, 05/16.

No formal motion hearing is needed to grant this motion.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court’s Office.
