Unless the court orders otherwise, parents are required, in an action in which legal custody or physical placement is contested, to file a written proposal for a parenting plan within 60 days after the court waives the mediation requirement under §767.405(8)(b) or the mediator under §767.405(12)(b) notifies the court that no

agreement has been reached.

If a parent does not file a proposed parenting plan, the right to contest the plan proposed by the other parent who does file may be lost. The judge can adopt the plan on file, unless the parent who did not file a plan can show mistake, inadvertence, surprise

or excusable neglect.
