Name of Form: Parties Approval of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Judgment – with Minor Children

Purpose of Form: This is the final document signed by the parties that approves the court's findings of fact concerning the marriage, the conclusions of law that apply, and the Judgment of Divorce or Legal Separation.

Who Completes It: The parties.

Distribution of Form: Court. Two additional copies of the document are required to be presented to the clerk for authentication and return to the parties.

Accompanying Forms: Any Marital Settlement Agreement or Order that has been approved by the court.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last updated 05/18.

Modification: Pursuant to 2019 WI Act 30, updated to add party/attorney address, email address and telephone number.

Comments: This form is used when the parties have minor children, as it includes the information relating to children's issues.

Because this form makes reference to and incorporates significant provisions from the Marital Settlement Agreement (FA-4150V) or Proposed Marital Settlement (FA-4152V), it should only be used in conjunction with that other appropriate document. Using this form without the other document may make these Findings, Conclusions or Judgment incomplete or inaccurate.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
