Name of Form: Stipulation Converting Legal Separation to Divorce

Form Number: FA-4162VA

Statutory Reference: §§765.03(2), 767.35 and 767.395, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form: After a legal separation has been granted, the parties may use this form to have the legal separation converted into a judgment of divorce.

Who Completes It: Both of the parties to the legal separation must sign the document.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court. Copies should be kept by both parties.

Accompanying Forms: The State of Wisconsin Vital Statistics form must be attached to the motion.

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 01/09.

Modification: Incorporated same sex language and added, "PARTIES MUST INCLUDE A PROPOSED ORDER THAT WILL ONLY BECOME ENFORCEABLE IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE OR CIRCUIT COURT COMMISSIONER."

Comments: Split to eFiling, 05/16.

The stipulation can be filed by the parties at any time after the legal separation has been granted.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
