

## FORM SUMMARY

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**Name of Form:** Stipulation to Vacate/Revoke the Judgment of Divorce or Legal Separation

**Form Number:** FA-4164VA

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**Statutory Reference:** §767.35(6), Wisconsin Statutes

**Benchbook Reference:**

**Purpose of Form:** This form allows parties to stipulate to vacate or revoke a judgment of divorce or legal separation. This eliminates need for a court hearing.

**Who Completes It:** Parties who seek the change complete the form and present it to the Child Support Agency and the court.

**Distribution of Form:** Original to court, copies to each of the parties.

**Accompanying Forms:** Generally none.

**New Form/Modification:** Modified; last update 2/10.

**Modifications:** Incorporated same sex language. Added revoke the judgment language and option that parties have remarried. Added, "PARTIES MUST INCLUDE A PROPOSED ORDER THAT WILL ONLY BECOME ENFORCEABLE IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE OR CIRCUIT COURT COMMISSIONER."

**Comments:** Split for eFiling, 05/16.

After this form is signed by the court and filed, the Clerk of Circuit Court will impound the record and the record will be sealed and no longer available to the public or the parties, except by special order.

**About this Form:** This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

**As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.**
