Purpose of Form: This form is used to make a written version of the decision of the judge or court commissioner following a hearing to modify a prior order concerning legal custody, physical placement, child support, maintenance or some other matter in a family case.

Who Completes It: The court official who heard the matter will sign the document. The court official may complete the document personally or may direct one of the parties to complete the document and submit it to the court official for signing.

Distribution of Form: Original to Court file, Copies to all parties

Accompanying Forms: Generally none

New Form/Modification: Modification; last update 01/09.

Modification: New rule which took effect Jan. 1, 2010 to DCF 150, the Percentage of Income Standard which creates requirements for establishing medical support orders. Under the new rules, a parent who has insurance coverage available that means certain defined criteria must carry that coverage and the other parent may be ordered to contribute to the cost of that coverage. That contribution would be in the form of an upward or downward deviation in the child support amount dependent on which parent is the court ordered payee.

Comments: Although a party may bring either a Motion (FA-4170V) or an Order to Show Cause (FA-4171V) to seek a modification of a current family court order, this Decision and Order may be used in either situation to make a written record of the decision.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office.

As a *pro se* form, its use is NOT mandatory but it is required to be accepted and distributed by the circuit courts of the State of Wisconsin.
