Objection to Registration of Out-of-State Judgment or Order

I object to the Registration of the Out-of-State Judgment or Order. I request a hearing at which I will prove the grounds stated below.

- 1. I object to registration of the judgment or order as to **child custody or placement** because:
 - A. The issuing court did not have jurisdiction under the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Enforcement Act.
 - B. The judgment or order has been vacated, stayed, or modified by a court having jurisdiction to do so under the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Enforcement Act.
 - C. I was entitled to notice, but notice was not given in accordance with the standards of Wis. Stat. §822.08 in the proceedings before the court that issued the judgment or order.

- 2. I object to registration of the judgment or order as to **support or maintenance** because:
 - A. The issuing tribunal lacked personal jurisdiction over me.
 - B. The judgment or order was obtained by fraud
 - C. The judgment or order has been vacated, suspended or modified by a later order.
 - D. The issuing tribunal has stayed the judgment or order pending appeal.
 - E. There is a defense under the law of this state to the remedy sought.
 - F. Full or partial payment has been made.
 - G. The statute of limitations under Wis. Stat. §769.604(2) precludes enforcement of some or all of the arrearages.
 - H. The judgment or order is not the controlling order.

- 3. I object to registration of the judgment or order as to **property division or an issue other than custody, placement, support, or maintenance** because:
 - A. An appeal is pending, or will be taken, from the judgment or order.
 - B. A stay of execution of the judgment or order has been granted.
 - C. There are grounds to reopen, vacate, or stay the judgment or order.
