<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To allow a parent who has been awarded periods of physical placement to seek enforcement of a physical placement order.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	The party who seeks to enforce a physical placement order. This person shall be identified as the petitioner, regardless of whether that person was the petitioner or respondent in the underlying action.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Original to court, copies to petitioner for service on respondent.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	Notice of Hearing to Enforce Periods of Physical Placement. FA-609 & FA-610.
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modification; last update 10/06.
<b>Modifications:</b>	Added Final Judgment/Order (Wamboldt) language.
<b>Comments:</b>	<p>Form created to be used with new Statute §767.242, created by §3054dd. 1999 Wisconsin Act 9. The section takes effect on May 1, 2000 (1999 Act 9, §9457(7yo)).</p> <p>Although §767.242(3)(c) requires the acceptance of any legible petition the committee believes that it is appropriate to have a standard form available for use so that all information required by §767.242(3)(a) and (b) is provided.</p> <p>§767.242(3)(d) provides that the petition shall be filed under the principal action under which the periods of physical placement were awarded.</p>
