When that judgment or lien is satisfied in whole or in part, a certified copy (transcript) of that satisfaction is sent to the clerk of court in the other counties where the judgment or lien has been docketed so that it can be enter the satisfaction on that county's records.

**Who Completes It:** Clerk of Circuit Court.

**Who Signs It:** Clerk of Circuit Court. COURT SEAL.

**Distribution of Form:** Clerk of Court; copy: Certified copy to Clerk of Court in counties where transcripts of original judgment/lien were docketed.
