Name of Form: Certificate of Appearance (Subpoena)

Purpose of Form: To provide a means by which a party to an action can cause a person to appear in a court proceeding and be able to give testimony. Also provides means to require that person bring specified documents to court.

Who Completes It: Party seeking the order.

Distribution of Form: Original is filed with clerk of court if county is required to pay witness fees; copies to sheriff or process server for service with required fee.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modification, last update 06/02.

Modifications: Modified distribution of form to indicate when clerk of court would receive original subpoena for filing. Also, made it clear that the subpoena needs to be served through the sheriff or a private process server.
