| <b>Purpose of Form:</b>       | To meet the jurisdictional requirements of the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (Chapter 822, Wisconsin Statutes) by providing information concerning a child for any “child custody proceeding.”                   |
| <b>Who Completes It:</b>      | Party filing the pleading beginning the action.   |
| <b>Distribution of Form:</b>  | Clerk of Court, copies for service on all of the other parties.   |
| <b>Accompanying Forms:</b>    | Generally the form will accompany a petition in some type of a child custody proceeding. If the form’s instructions indicate an attachment is needed because of space limitations, that attachment should be included.                    |
| <b>New Form/Modification:</b> | Modification; last update 09/24.  |
| <b>Modifications:</b>         | Removed references to affidavit as part of 23 Wis Act 245 (unsworn declaration).  |
| <b>Comments:</b>              | The form may be used for more than one child. Previously its wording technically limited the form to use for a single child, potentially requiring several copies of the same declaration when a proceeding involved more than one child. |
| <b>About this Form:</b>       | This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court’s Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.   |
