Name of Form: Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act Affidavit

Form Number: GF-150

Statutory Reference: §822.29, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference: FA-14-3

Purpose of Form: To meet the jurisdictional requirements of the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (chapter 822, Wisconsin Statutes) by providing information concerning a child for any “child custody proceeding.”

Who Completes It: Party filing the pleading beginning the action.

Distribution of Form: Original to Clerk of Court, Copies for service on all of the other parties.

Accompanying Forms: Generally the form will accompany a petition in some type of a child custody proceeding. If the form’s instructions indicate an attachment is needed because of space limitations, that attachment should be included.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 05/18.

Modification: Deleted notary section and added a declaration statement.

Comments: A set of instructions has been added along the left-hand side of the form to explain the information that should be inserted into the blanks.

The form has been expanded in concept to allow it to be used for more than one child. Previously its wording technically limited the form to use for a single child, potentially requiring several copies of the same affidavit when a proceeding involved more than one child.

About this Form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court’s Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial conference.
