THE COURT FINDS:

Concurrent jurisdiction between state court and tribal court

- does not exist.
- exists and this is not a case involving the custody or placement of children. After consideration of the factors in §801.54, Wis. Stats., the Court determines that a transfer to tribal court is appropriate.
