 - failed to perform any duties of a guardian of the estate or performed acts prohibited to a guardian of the estate as specified in §§54.18, 54.19, 54.20, 54.22, and 54.62, Wis. Stats.
3. Changed circumstances indicate that a previously unavailable volunteer guardian of the estate is available to serve as guardian of the estate and that the change is in the best interests of the minor ward.
