<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To appoint a Full, Limited, or Temporary Guardian of the child and issue letters of guardianship and dispositional order appointing guardian for an Indian child.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	Court: Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner. This is a final order for the purpose of appeal.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s guardian, child’s legal custodian, child’s Guardian ad Litem/Adversary Counsel, Tribe, Indian Custodian, and any additional interested persons.

Unless the court orders otherwise, any decision concerning the child must be concurred in by all co-guardians or is void. Wis. Stat. §48.9795 (2)(b)(4). If co-guardians are ordered, both names shall be included on the order.</p>
