| Purpose of Form: | <p>To give notice to parents that a petition to terminate parental rights has been filed and to summons the parents to court for a hearing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If this is the first notice for an involuntary termination of parental rights proceeding involving a child subject to the Indian Child Welfare Act, it must be provided to the parent/Indian custodian and the tribe by registered mail with a return receipt requested.• If the identity or location of the tribe cannot be determined, notice must be sent by registered mail with return receipt requested to the Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs. |
| Who Completes It: | Petitioner, Petitioner's Attorney, or court official. |
| Who Signs It: | BY THE COURT: Circuit Court Judge, or Petitioner, Petitioner's Attorney. |
| Distribution of Form: | Court; authenticated copies for service. |
| Accompanying Forms: | The Petition for Termination of Parental Rights accompanies the Summons when served. |
| New Form/Modification: | Modified; last update 10/09. |
| Modifications: | Added signature requirement language for Notice of Intent. 2017 WI Act 258, which went into effect on 4/6/18. |
| Comments: | Initial notice of all ICWA cases must be sent by registered mail with return receipt requested to the Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs. |
