- If this is the first notice in a child in need of protection or services, juvenile in need of protection or services, or involuntary termination of parental rights proceeding involving a child/juvenile subject to the Indian Child Welfare Act:
 - Notice must be provided to the parent, Indian custodian and the tribe by registered mail with return receipt requested. In addition, notice must be sent as required by §938.27 and §48.27, Wis. Stats. If the identity or location of the parent or tribe cannot be determined, notice must be sent by registered mail with return receipt requested to the Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs.
 - The parent, Indian custodian, or tribe has the right to request up to 20 additional days to prepare for the hearing.
- Notice to the parent, Indian custodian, and tribe of subsequent hearings must be in writing by mail, personal delivery, or fax, but not by email.
- A parent, Indian custodian, or tribe has the right to intervene at any point in the proceeding and to request transfer to tribal court.
- If a parent or Indian custodian wants to be represented by an attorney and cannot afford one, the State Public Defender may appoint an attorney.
- If a child/juvenile wants to be represented by an attorney, or the child/juvenile is required to be represented by an attorney, the State Public Defender may appoint an attorney.

If you require reasonable accommodations due to a disability to participate in the court process, please call _____ prior to the scheduled court date. Please note that the court does not provide transportation.

- Based on ability to pay, the parents may be ordered to reimburse the state or county for the cost of an attorney.
- Potential consequences of this proceeding may include:
 - Removal of child/juvenile from the home of the parent(s), guardian, or Indian custodian.
 - Placement outside the home, including a relative home, foster home, group home, or residential care center.
 - A finding that the child/juvenile is in need of protection or services.
 - A dispositional order entered containing specific conditions of supervision and/or return.
 - Transfer of legal custody.
 - Potential grounds for future termination of parental rights.
- Parties shall keep all information contained in this notice confidential.
